### *Reflection Questions*

- (1) What are your normal responses in times of stress and fear? Psalms 3-7 give voice to David's fears and worry over his enemies. What do we learn about how we are to respond to stress and fear from the way Psalm 8 begins? How does David gain clarity and understanding?*
- (2) Psalm 8 tells us about God's transcendence (His glory is above the heavens), but we also learn that God is immanent (v. 4). How do these realities about God comfort you? What happens when we lose sight of these two truths?*
- (3) What are your positions of influence? Does your influence reflect the way Christ uses his power?*
