Prayers of Thanksgiving and Intercession

Creator God, we praise you for the beauty and diversity of your vast creation. You set the earth on its foundations and stretched out the heavens like a garment. You are able to measure the waters in the hollow of your hand and weigh the mountains in scales and the hills in a balance. The nations are like a drop from a bucket in your sight. You do not faint or grow weary. Your understanding is unsearchable. You are the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. Hear us now, O Lord, as we offer you praise and honor for your creative power.

God of justice, you are not a God who delights in wickedness or walks with those who do evil. You have declared to us what we are to do. You have made it clear that we are to do justice and to love kindness and to walk humbly with you. You warn us to amend our ways and act justly with one another. You have continually made it clear that we are to protect the alien, orphan, widow, and all the vulnerable in our communities. O Lord, you judge us in righteousness and know the very secrets of our hearts. Hear us now, O Lord, as we pray for justice to be done, beginning with each of us.

God of mercy and compassion, you are near to the brokenhearted. You save those who are crushed in spirit. You tell us that many are the afflictions of the righteous, but you rescue them from them all. There are many, O Lord, who are weighed down with heavy, painful sorrows. Many who are looking for help and crying out to be rescued. O Lord, we trust in your mercy and compassion, so hear us now, as we pray for those who are suffering and needing your consolations that can cheer the soul.

God of reconciliation, in Christ you have established your new covenant where the dividing wall between people has been broken. It is in Christ that there is no longer Jew or Greek, slave or free, male or female; for we are all one in Christ Jesus. We are told that when we are in Christ, we are new creations and all that is old has passed away. In Christ, you have called us to fulfill the law by loving our neighbor as we love ourselves. In Christ, we are called to put to death the sinful deeds of our flesh and be led by the Spirit, bearing fruit that honors you. O Lord, hear us now, as we cry out to you to bring healing and reconciliation to our world through the good news of Christ Jesus.

God of enduring hope, our confidence is not in ourselves but in your power to bring something beautiful, enduring, and good out of nothing. In the very beginning, you brought life into existence without conflict or violence. And so, even today, amid the brokenness, injustice, and despair of our world, we believe and trust that you will not fail in doing good. The cross of Jesus Christ was foolishness and shame in the eyes of the world, but we know it is your power and wisdom. O Lord, may we be your people who live out the message of the cross, hoping against hope and trusting your power to bring life into a dark and hurting world.
