

## "Vaya Con Dios"


Your Living Waters for the World, (LWW), team has been trying to learn Spanish ever since the decision was made to go to Peru. Now that we have made two trips and many, many friends, we realize even more the importance of effective communication with these sweet people. Regardless of the circumstances, we and our Peruvian pals understand the meaning of "Vaya Con Dios" ~ Go with God.

In every step along the way, we are reminded that God goes with us, guiding our actions, providing inspiration, and sometimes winking at us. ;-) Thank you to our Trinity family for your support in this endeavor; we feel the love that you have shown with your many donations and prayers. Through your hard work, the Jelly Bean Run, held April 20, was even more successful than last year with over \$23,000 made toward Living Waters for the World! Many thanks go to Jelly Bean 5K Team Leader Carol Powell, the Presbyterian Women, and countless others for their generosity of time and money. These funds enabled us to return to Peru the following week to sign the LWW covenant and begin preparations for the installation during early September.

The unfolding of events during our visit reminded us that we were, indeed, walking with God. Starting with the formation of the required water committee, we felt His hand on our backs. Not only does the committee have a minister who will keep the focus on the spiritual benefits of working together, but also with Rev. Gimbler comes his charming wife who will provide leadership to the educational component. God winked at us again when we found out that a lawyer on the water committee has a cousin who provided leadership to another LWW installation in Suyobamba. Is that not amazing? Of course, working with Greg and Linda English and their Reimagine Peru team continues to be a blessing. Now they are finishing the dorms in their new building, which will provide housing for us when the full team returns. This will save four hours of dusty transport time to and from the hotel in Lima. What a saving of time and money! The most amazing parts of our visit were the collegial way the members of the committee made important decisions and their eagerness to do whatever they could to assist our efforts.

Now, the enthusiasm for our Peru mission is spreading through the Trinity congregation and the Cordova Park community. Our vacation Bible school will use the curriculum designed to educate others in the work of providing clean water to all God's children. In addition, the VBS children and their families can get involved by donating a box of crayons, a pack of construction paper, or any number of materials needed for the "school" we will be conducting in Jicamarca during our visit in September.

We have a long way to go and many steps to take between now and the installation, but we are certain that we "Vaya Con Dios."



## A Letter from USA Director

We at Send56 are committed to training and sending national African missionaries to unreached areas throughout Africa. We believe the Lord gave us a strategy to bring the gospel to the remaining unreached people groups in Africa by 2050.

This past year, we reaped a harvest of over 500 people won to Christ! Additionally, we established ten new churches and are currently discipling 160 people in unreached areas. Besides that, over 300 students have been discipled and trained in our MAP school's since the inception of the ministry.


